It is important to leave a space around the logo. No text or other visual elements should appear within this space. The 'X' space is $\frac{5}{8}$ of the width of the logo.



The 'X' distance created from the x-height of the top line to the baseline of the bottom line

The Minimum Size



14mm

It is very important that the logo is never reproduced smaller than this size. This is the minimum size it can be reproduced without compromising the legibility.

DON'T CHANGE THE LOGO

It is important that the logo is not altered or distorted in any way. There are three versions of the logo, these are the only acceptable versions. Some examples of changes that should never be made to the logo:

Alter



Place at an angle



Colour



Remove Elements



Flip

Italicise



Muddle up colours

LOGO ALTERNATIVE

On occasions the main logo can be replaced by the typographic logo as a method of preventing the overuse or repetition of the main logo or where there isn't enough room to present the main logo as effectively.

Dark Palette colours use white



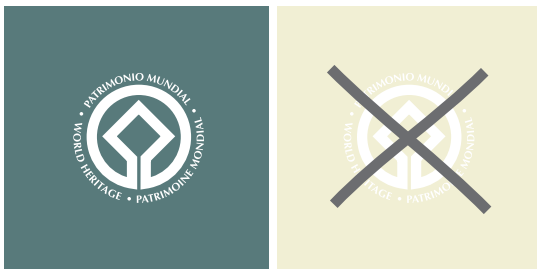
LOGO Versions

Other related organisations logos need to be used in conjunction with the Blaenavon World Heritage Logo. These logos are to be either black or white. The two logos always appear side by side.

Tonal Values

The logo needs to be legible against the background colour. If the logo is placed on a background colour the tonal values of the background colour have to be dark or light enough for the logo to appear clearly.

SIDE BAND

When the side band is used, the width is calculated as follows; landscape format is an 1/8 of the width of total size, portrait format is a 1/5 of total size. This is standard for all sizes from A0 to A5. DL size is 1/4 of width.



It is important that the font is legible. Lighter colours work better on a dark background, dark colours on a light background and mid colours work well on both. Photo's used in design boxes should always be duo tone.

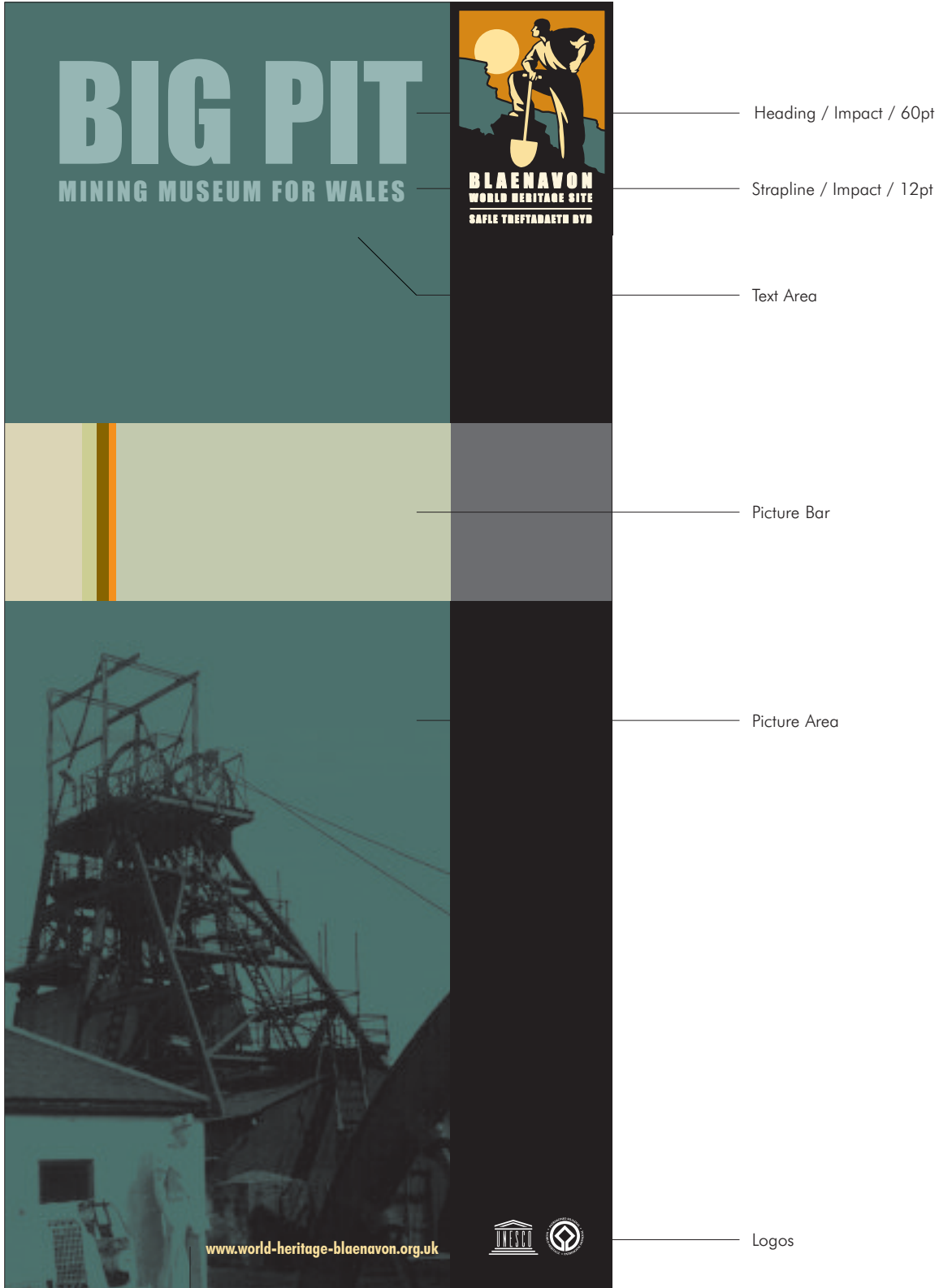
